

NW Canada - Mountains, Tundra & the Midnight Sun



Highlights - 23 days, 56 hrs, 5600 NM

This ultimate Canadian wilderness trip includes the Rocky Mountains, the northern tundra, the Great Canadian Shield, the gold rush towns of Dawson and Whitehorse, a remote luxury lodge accessible only by floatplane and a day trip to Tuktoyaktuk on the Arctic Ocean. You will experience 24-hours of daylight under the Midnight Sun and see parts of the country not even seen by most Canadians. A trip not to be missed.



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Days 1,2 - Arrive Toronto / Kitchener Waterloo [CYKF]

Trip preparation days

Day 3 - Sault Ste Marie, Ontario [CYAM]

Beautiful flight along the north shores of Lake Huron.

Day 4 - Winnipeg, Manitoba [CYWG]

A flight along the wild north shore of Lake Superior, the largest of the Great Lakes.

Day 5 - Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan [CJS4]

Fly across the vast prairies, Canada's breadbasket.

Days 6, 7, 8 - Calgary, Alberta [CYBW] / Banff National Park

A chance to pause and explore world famous Banff National Park as we spend 3 nights in the Banff Springs Hotel.

Days 9 - Fort Nelson [CYYE]

A more remote town and jumping-off point for our flight through the Rockies.

Days 10, 11, 12 - Whitehorse [CYXY]

A spectacular flight as we follow the Alaska Highway through the Rocky Mountains. Here we will tour the many historical sites in this frontier town and do a day trip to Skagway Alaska.

Days 13, 14 - Dawson City [CYDA]

Another incredible flight following the Klondike Highway to Dawson, a famous gold rush town.

Days 15, 16 - Inuvik / Tuktoyaktuk [CYEV]

Inuvik is one of Canada's most northerly towns. We will do a day trip by boat, with a local guide, up the MacKenzie River delta to Tuktoyaktuk, where you will be able to dip your foot in the Arctic Ocean!

Days 17, 18, 19 - Yellowknife [CYZF]

We cross the vast tundra and then spend two nights at a wilderness lodge accessible only by seaplane, for a quintessential Canadian experience, before returning for one night at Yellowknife.

Days 20, 21, 22 - Thompson [CYTH], Killarney [CPT2]

A traverse across the Canadian Shield with its seemingly endless forests, land lakes. We finally arrive at Killarney in Georgian Bay, a favourite summer destination for the locals and seaplanes.

Day 23 - Kitchener/Waterloo [CYKF]

A last short flight before returning to KW and Toronto and then home.
