

NW Canada - Mountains & Tundra



Highlights - 23 days, 49 hrs, 5450 NM

The ultimate Canadian wilderness trip; includes the Rocky Mountains, the northern tundra, the Great Canadian Shield, the gold rush towns of Dawson and Whitehorse and even the towns of Inuvik and Tuktoyaktuk on the Arctic Ocean! We'll even do some fishing for Lake Trout on Great Slave Lake, a classic Canadian experience. A trip not to be missed.



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Days 1,2 - Arrive Toronto / Kitchener Waterloo [CYKF]

Trip preparation days

Day 3 - Sault Ste Marie, Ontario [CYAM]

Beautiful flight along the north shores of Lake Huron.

Day 4 - Winnipeg, Manitoba [CYWG]

A flight along the wild north shore of Lake Superior, the largest of the Great Lakes.

Day 5 - Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan [CJS4]

Fly across the vast prairies, Canada's breadbasket.

Days 6, 7, 8 - Calgary, Alberta [CYBW]

A chance to pause and do some touring in the local area including an overnight at famous Lake Louise and the Banff Springs Hotel. Pilots will take a ½ day mountain flying training course.

Days 9, 10 - Fort Nelson [CYYE]

An extra day for a possible weather wait before we head to Whitehorse.

Days 11, 12, 13 - Whitehorse [CYXY]

One of the most spectacular flights of the trip, through the Rocky Mountains. Once there, we will tour the sites in this historical town and take a day trip to Skagway Alaska.

Days 14, 15 - Dawson City [CYDA]

Another incredible flight following the Klondike Highway to Dawson, a famous gold rush town.

Days 16, 17 - Inuvik / Tuktoyaktuk [CYEV]

And now, to one of Canada's most northerly towns and, weather permitting, ultimately to Tuktoyaktuk, where you will be able to dip your foot in the Arctic Ocean!

Days 18, 19 - Yellowknife [CYZF] / Great Slave Lake

Our first day across the tundra, Canada's Outback! We will stay on Great Slave Lake at a fishing lodge where we can try some serious Lake Trout fishing, a classic Canadian summer pastime.

Days 20, 21, 22 - Thompson [CYTH], Red Lake [CYRL]. Killarney [CPT2]

A traverse across the vast Canadian Shield. More forest, lakes and wilderness than most places in the world. We finally arrive at Killarney, a traditional summer lodge once only accessible by float plane.

Day 23 - Kitchener/Waterloo [CYKF]

A last short flight before returning to KW and Toronto and then home.
